The Juneau-Douglas City Museum recruits Museum interns for 10-week to 6-month internships on an on-going basis. Currently we are recruiting for an internship to begin in September 2010. The Museum welcomes all serious applicants but gives priority to graduate students in Museum Studies and six-month internships.

The Juneau-Douglas City Museum is a small, dynamic, municipally operated, local history and art Museum in Juneau, Alaska's capital with the mission of fostering an awareness and appreciation of Juneau's rich cultural heritage.

The Museum's collection includes totem poles, contemporary art, mining artifacts and historical objects that interpret the area's rich Tlingit, gold mining, political, and multi-cultural history. In addition to caring for and exhibiting the collection, the Museum offers a variety of on-going educational and public programs.

Intern responsibilities vary seasonally. In addition to special Museum projects, interns participate in the diverse responsibilities and activities involved with working in a small community driven institution.

We offer furnished housing (including all utilities) a \$100 per week stipend and a monthly bus pass.

Interested candidates are required to send a current resume and letter of interest to Jane Lindsey, Director outlining what they expect to gain from an internship including specific dates of availability. A final application must provide three letters of recommendations from professors and/or museum professionals and official college and graduate school transcripts.
